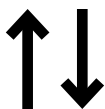

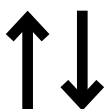
2. **Judges 1:19**—After Joshua died, the people became afraid of the Canaanites with iron chariots.



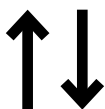
3. **Judges 2:2**—The Israelites disobeyed God and failed to destroy the idolaters and tear down their altars and idols.



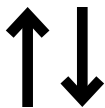
4. **Judges 2:11, 12**—The Israelites did evil. They forsook God and worshiped the gods of the Canaanites.



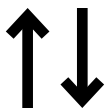
5. **Judges 3:9**—The Israelites cried out to God; and He sent Othniel, a judge, to help them.



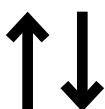
6. **Judges 3:12**—When Othniel died, the people did evil again. So God let the Moabites defeat the Israelites.
