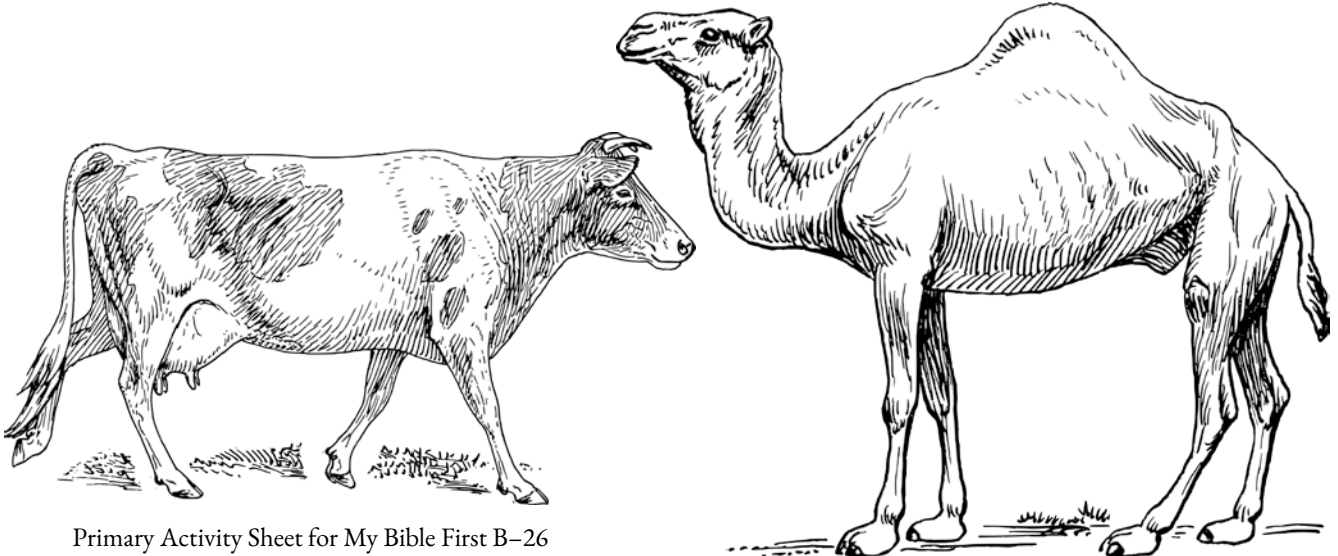


The Story of Job

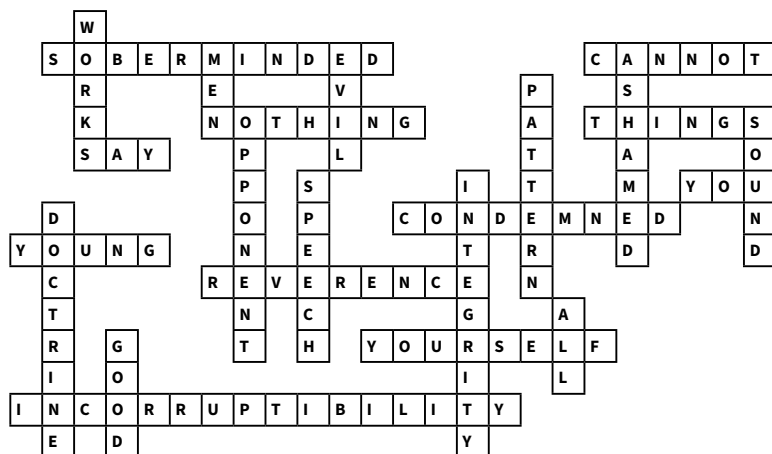
